What it is:

The Career Achievement Award is an award given by the Learning for Life branch of the Boy Scouts of America. Aviation Explorers are eligible for the award.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Learning for Life Career Achievement Award program is to:

- Provide direction to Explorers and student participants in individual career proficiency.
- Motivate Explorers and student participants to discover and take on career opportunities.
- Recognize Explorers and student participants for significant community service.
- Give Explorers and student participants distinguished credentials for their résumés.

Requirements:

To be eligible for the Career Award, Aviation Explorers Post 2009 participants must:

- Attend all regularly scheduled meetings for Post 2009
- Complete 50 hours of community service
- Wash at least one aircraft
- Complete the Career Achievement Award application and submit it to the post advisor
